

Annual Meeting

In May our League honored Jan Stanley for her many successful years as a high school athletic coach at West Henderson High School and celebrated forty years of Title IX and opportunites now available to young women.

At the meeting the members elected Helen Wright as Vice-President and Grace Poli as Secretary. In addition, Iris Vanek, Barbara Updike and Bill Wilkes were elected as Directors. Becky Banadyga was elected chair and Marion Huffman a member of the Nominating Committee for 2012-2012. A third member will be appointed by the 2012-2013 Board. The annual budget was also adopted.

Immigration Study Comittee

- President Obama's Executive Policy gives new hope to undocumented young adults (ages 16 30 years) who to be eligible for employment under the following conditions: to have been in the United States at least five years and were present in the US on June 15, 2012; have no record of serious crime; currently in school, have graduated from high school, or obtained a general education diploma (GED) or be an honorably discharged veteran of the Coast Guard or U. S. Armed forces. A fee will be charged for the authorization of a deferred action to be processed.
- Dick Durbin has reintroduced the DREAM ACT -- watch for call to action. Senator Hagan was one of the senators who voted against this bill last time it came up for a vote. It lost in the Senate by only 5 votes. While visiting Senator Hagan's office in Asheville when delivering the cards signed by the public at the two forums at BRCC in March, her staff relayed the message that she would support it this time. League will be watching this carefully. Change in position is possible!
- New members to League who have joined the Immigration Committee are Marge Cullen and Michele Burnett. The loss of long-time and passionate member, Joe Glowacki, will leave a gaping void. Kathleen Lees has also chosen to resign due to many other commitments. Thank you, Kathleen. The committee meets regularly for one hour at 3 PM the third Monday of each month at St. James Episcopal Church. Observers and/or new members are always welcome. Next meeting is August 20.
- Glenn Rodgers is developing a different version (shorter) of the Immigration Issues to accommodate those audiences that have only time for a twenty or twenty-five minute presentation. The focus will be "Facts vs Myths".
- 1200 undocumented immigrants were able to receive appropriate ID when the Mexican Consulate visited June 16 at BRCC.
