- September 28: Voter Services is hosting a presentation at the general meeting. Beverly Cunningham (the Director of the Henderson County Board of Elections) and the three other members of the BOE have been invited to explain the make-up and budget of the BOE, the processing of voter registrations, what happens during an actual election, and the consideration of felons. 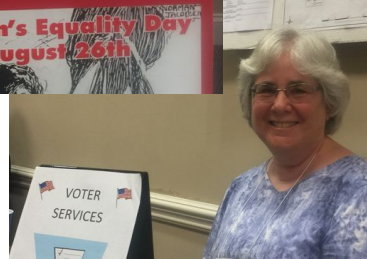
## Ratify ERA NC
