WHAT DO ELECTION WORKERS DO? (Don't worry - you'll be trained! Shifts are available during One-Stop Early Voting.)

- Staff polling places during One-Stop Early Voting and on Election Day
- Set up and close down the voting enclosure
- Check in voter and issue ballots
- Assist voters upon request
- Conduct curbside voting

DO YOU QUALIFY?

- You must be a registered voter to be a precinct official on Election Day.
- You do NOT have to be registered to work at an One-Stop Early Voting site.
- If you are 17, you qualify to be a student election assistant.

You will be paid by the hour for working at a One-Stop Early Voting site. On Election Day, you will be paid depending on the job description. We are committed to protecting election workers' and voters' health and safety. Appropriate personal protective equipment will be provided.
